

Practical info for KUNO annual network meeting in Turku

Arrival options and getting around:

- Helsinki-Vantaa airport
 - From the airport you can either take a bus or a train to Turku. If you take the train, please notice that you will first take the local train to Pasila (the last train station before Helsinki main station) and change to the train to Turku (Kupittaa). The Trains from Helsinki (and Pasila) towards Turku are not currently going to the main train station because of renovations. The train will stop in Kupittaa, about 3 km from the city centre. From Kupittaa you can get to the city centre with the bus or taxi. Train schedules: <https://www.vr.fi/en>
 - Bus goes directly to Turku. Some of the buses require you to switch from one bus to another, but the buses are next to each other. Bus schedules: <https://www.matkahuolto.fi/en>
- Turku airport
 - You can also fly to Turku airport. From the airport you can take the local bus line (bus line #1) to the city centre or a Taxi. The bus takes less than 30 minutes
- Turku harbour
 - If you arrive by boat, the bus line #1 takes you from the harbour to the city centre.
- Local bus (Föli)
 - The local bus in Turku is called Föli. For routes and timetables: <https://www.foli.fi/en>
